Services in this office are provided by registered nurses, nurse practitioners and a physician who acts as a consultant to the practice. Treatment for routine illnesses, management of chronic conditions, and preventive care are provided. Should care be needed beyond the scope of nursing staff practice, referrals will be made to Heritage Family Medicine or a provider of the student's choice.

CONFIDENTIALITY

All contacts with the Health Service or its staff are strictly confidential. No medical information will be released, including to parents, without permission of the student except in the case of communicable diseases where, by law, the Department of Health is notified, or to others in a life-threatening situation.

SERVICES AVAILABLE

- On-campus first aid, assessment and treatment for minor accidents or illnesses including respiratory infections, urinary tract infections, mononucleosis, sexually transmitted infections, and others

- Over-the-counter medicines and supplies as well as commonly ordered prescriptions
- Diagnostic testing including strep tests, pregnancy testing, and specific lab work as ordered by the nurse practitioner
- Physicals (extra charge applies)
- Birth control, gynecologic exams, and STD testing
- Complete referral services for care beyond the scope of a nurse practitioner
- Nutrition counseling and meal plans
- Health education and information
- Resident Advisor training
- Advising to student groups

Limited services are also available to faculty and staff through the Employee Wellness Program.

HEALTH FEES

Most services and supplies are covered under the student's tuition; however, a separate charge may apply in some circumstances. A statement will be made available for insurance purposes. All medical expenses incurred outside the Health Service are the responsibility of the student or the parent. A Student Insurance Plan is available through Health Services, but is **not** required in order to receive services in the Health Office.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation for healthcare may be arranged as deemed necessary by the Health Office staff, Resident Director, or Campus Safety. Refer to the Student Handbook for a copy of our transportation policy.

HEALTH FORMS

All students are required to submit a college physical, immunization record, and proof of health insurance prior to starting classes. All students must comply with the NY State immunization laws to attend class, including signing a meningitis information sheet. Failure to submit the required forms may result in exclusion from classes. Forms are available online and from Admissions or the Health Office. **After the initial physical, sports history updates are also required yearly for athletes.**

MEDICAL EXCUSES

The student is responsible for notifying his/her instructors of absences caused by illness or injury. Emergency situations and conditions will be handled on an individual basis.
