MBA Accelerated Path Agreement  
Timeline & Overview**

By March 1 <sup>st</sup> of the Junior Year at Cazenovia College	Complete the application process for admission to the Master of Business Administration Degree Program at LeMoyne College (MBA). The MBA is open to any and all undergraduate majors.														
Prior to your senior year at Cazenovia College	<p>During their undergraduate studies at Cazenovia College, students will fulfill the undergraduate equivalents for the <b>five foundation course requirements</b> for the MBA program. Introduction to Financial and Managerial Accounting (ACT 501), Business Communications (BUS 501), Economics for Managers (ECO 501), Management Information Systems (MIS 501), and Quantitative Decision Making (STA 501). Minimally, to waive one graduate course requires the student to take two undergraduate courses (6 credit hours) and achieve a minimal “B” or greater in each course. Senior Year at Cazenovia College	If desires, enroll in HRM 601 (3CH), MIS 601 (3CH), and / or MGT 601 (3CH) <sup>2</sup> . Students may take one or more of these graduate courses at LeMoyne College during their senior year. The tuition charge for these courses will be the prevailing Lemoyne College non-matriculated undergraduate tuition rate. The plan is developed in this manner to minimize the financial burden while the student is still enrolled in their undergraduate program.														
Summer following Cazenovia College Graduation	Students <b>must provide an official degree bearing transcript to the LeMoyne College Office of Graduate Admission</b> . After receipt of the transcript and assuming that the student is in good academic standing, then he or she will be officially admitted to the Lemoyne College MBA program.														
Graduate School at LeMoyne College	The remainder of the MBA Program (27 credit hours <sup>3</sup> ) can be completed within the one year (fall, J-semester, spring, Maymester and Summer terms). If the student is full time. If preferable, the student may complete the program part time. The student must matriculate into the LeMoyne MBA program in the summer following graduation from their undergraduate degree program at Cazenovia College.														

<sup>1</sup>Six undergraduate credit hours beyond the survey level of an undergraduate discipline and a Grade of “B” or better in each undergraduate course is required to waive a graduate level course.

<sup>2</sup>Students must provide an official degree bearing transcript to the LeMoyne College Office of Graduate Admission. After receipt of the transcript, and assuming that the student is in good Academic standing, then he/she will be officially admitted to the Lemoyne College MBA program.

<sup>3</sup>The remaining 27 hours assumes that all 5 graduate foundation course requirements have been filled and the student has taken the opportunity to enroll in and complete HRM 601 (3 CH), MIS 601 (3 CH), and/or MGT 601 (3 CH) during their senior year at Cazenovia College.
