



Study Japanese ... Study Abroad in Japan ...

Consider participating in the new Japanese program, available to students of all majors.

Students who take two semesters of Japanese language are eligible to study abroad in **Nagoya, Japan**, at the College's sister institution, Nagoya Gakuin University. The program is for the fall semester and involves studying Japanese culture and language, living in an international dormitory with students from around the world, and frequent field trips throughout Japan.



AFFORDABILITY

Pay the same for tuition and rooms as if you were studying and living on the Cazenovia campus.

Additional costs include a program fee, food, books, incidentals, and air travel to and from Japan.

Financial aid applies to this program.

ELIGIBILITY

Participants must be Cazenovia College students in good standing with a minimum 2.75 GPA and two semesters of Japanese language (or passing the equivalent exam).

Students can be sophomores, juniors or seniors and participation does not make a student ineligible for other Cazenovia study abroad programs.
