

TRANSFER PATHWAYS AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

**ONONDAGA COMMUNITY COLLEGE
SYRACUSE, NEW YORK**

AND

**CAZENOVIA COLLEGE
CAZENOVIA, NY**

This agreement establishes a pathway to transfer between Onondaga Community College and Cazenovia College. OCC students will, upon completion of a directed sequence of coursework leading to an associate degree from OCC are guaranteed admission to Cazenovia College at junior status. A full-time student should be able to complete the specific Cazenovia College degree in two years, as long as the required course work is followed with the minimum passing grades.

STUDENT SELECTION

The ideal candidate will have successfully completed high school with demonstrated proficiency in all core areas. The student must be a full-time matriculated student in one of OCC's academic programs specified in this agreement. Students may be considered to enter into this agreement at any time during their studies at OCC, but whether or not the student is eligible under the terms is contingent on their academic progress.

STUDENT ACADEMIC ADVISEMENT

OCC staff and faculty in cooperation with Cazenovia College assume responsibility for advising students who enter into the agreement. Academic curriculum advising guides will be used to communicate degree requirements to students, including recommendations for elective selection. While advising guides will be reviewed once per year for necessary revisions, any changes to coursework or academic curriculum will warrant an immediate revision.

OCC's Coordinator of Transfer Services and Cazenovia College's Associate Director of Transfer Admissions will be designated as contact persons and coordinators of the agreement.

TRANSFER ADMISSION

Students are encouraged to apply for admission to Cazenovia College at the start of their final semester at OCC. The application fee for students seeking admission in accordance with the agreement will be waived and the application will be given priority status.

Recommended Application Deadlines:

While Cazenovia College practices rolling admission, the following recommended deadlines should be considered when applying for admission through this agreement.

GPA Requirements:

Students must have a minimum of a 2.0 cumulative grade point average for acceptance to Cazenovia College. Students below the 2.0 minimum average may be considered for conditional acceptance.

General Education Expectations:

Cazenovia College requires all students to complete 39 credits of general education, which includes upper division level coursework. Traditionally, transfer students who complete an associate degree will have completed many of these 100/200-level general education requirements upon enrolling at Cazenovia College. 300/400-level coursework will be completed at Cazenovia College.

BACCALAUREATE DEGREE PROGRAMS


The degree programs listed in *Appendix A* may be selected by students who participate in the transfer agreement between Onondaga Community College and Cazenovia College.

REVERSE TRANSFER

When possible, Cazenovia College will encourage transfer students, who have transferred from Onondaga Community College without completing their associate degree, to attempt to complete the previous degree program. Reverse transfer allows students to transfer the credits they have earned at Cazenovia College back to Onondaga Community College, by which the Cazenovia College credit, in combination with the credit earned at Onondaga Community College, are evaluated to determine if courses completed satisfy the degree requirements for awarding an associate degree.






